

6.0 - All-League & All-State Selection Process

There will be mandatory post-season League Meetings for Varsity coaches. In order for your team to have player representation in post-season honors, and to be able to vote, the Head Varsity coach or an appointed proxy must attend (one (1) rep per each Varsity program) the meeting. Nominations and voting will happen at these meetings, and the meetings will be conducted by the appointed League Representative in conjunction with OGLA representation.* Meetings will be scheduled during the final week of the season and must be complete before the start of playoffs. The All-State Teams will be selected from the All-League Teams.

All-League teams will be selected for each of the five (5) Leagues. First and Second All-League teams will be named to recognize the best players in the League. There will be no more than 24 players named per League. At this meeting, each Coach will submit the name(s) of those players from their own team they feel deserve All-League recognition. Nominations will start with the lowest ranked teams.

1. Each Head Coach is asked to bring their player stats and a picture of the player(s) they intend to nominate in order to facilitate the voting process.
2. OGLA will provide a list of current players who have participated / are participating on NW Regional and Oregon Elite teams, or have previously earned All-American distinction.
3. Each Head Coach will vote for an all-opponent 24 member team (i.e. do not vote for your own players). Coaches will have 6 points to assign to Attack, 10 for Midfield, 6 for Defense and 2 for Goalies. The top player will receive 6 points, down to 1 point for your final vote per position group.
4. All schools must vote for the 24 selections from the league. If a school does not vote all slots, no players from that school will be recognized for All-League honors.
5. Each League Representative will be responsible for sending voting sheets to OGLA for tabulation. All votes will be confidential as every School's vote will be placed in individual enveloped and signed before turning over to League Rep at meeting.
6. The points will be tallied and the 12 players with the highest totals will be named to the All-League First team. The next 12 highest totals will be named to the All-League Second team. There will be no Honorable Mention teams at the League level.
7. Ties will be assigned to the appropriate team as determine by OGLA Board during tabulation.
8. All-League teams will be released during the playoffs.

All-State teams will be selected from the All League teams. Players earning All-State recognition are the top lacrosse athletes in Oregon. It is possible for a player who is second team All-League in one League to be named to All-State over a first team player in another League, but a player cannot leapfrog within their own League.

1. OGLA will e-mail each Varsity Head Coach a Ballot with All-State candidates. OGLA will also provide a list of current players who have participated / are participating on NW Regional and Oregon Elite teams, or have previously earned All-American distinction.
2. Each Head Coach will vote for an all-opponent 24 member team (do not vote for your own players). You will have 6 points to assign to Attack, 10 for Midfield, 6 for Defense and 2 for Goalies. The top player will receive max point, down to 1 point for your final vote per position group.
3. All schools must vote for the 24 selections from the State. If a school does not vote, no players from that school will be recognized for All State honors.
4. The points will be tallied and the 12 players with the highest totals will be named to the All-State First team. The next 12 highest totals will be named to the All-State Second team. The next 12 will be named Honorable Mention.
5. Ties will be assigned to the appropriate team as determine by OGLA Board during tabulation.

All-State teams will be announced at the State Championship game.

All All-League and All-State players will be awarded certificates recognizing their accomplishment. OGLA will send to a League Rep for distribution upon the completion of the playoffs.
