

LACROSSE STATISTICS

Quick and easy

GOAL: A goal should only be recorded if the signal for such has been given by the official.

OWN GOAL: A goal scored by a member of the defensive team is recorded as an "own goal."

No shot is recorded for the attacking team.

Note that goals are recorded with respect to time INTO the game. Thus, if a goal is scored with 25:45 on the clock in the first half, it is recorded as 4:15. A goal scored with 25:45 left on the clock in the second half is recorded as 34:15.

SHOT: A shot is any attempt made by a player to score a goal.

Note also that officially there is no such thing as a "shot on goal." All shots are recorded as just that—shots.

8m FREE POSITION AWARDED: An 8-meter free position (otherwise referred to as an 8-meter attempt) is recorded for a team if that team is awarded such by an official.

This is a team statistic; individual attempts are not marked. A running total is kept on the recording sheet for a team.

ASSIST: An assist is a play made by a player to a teammate who then scores a goal. There can be only one assist per goal.

DRAW CONTROL: A draw control is awarded to the player that controls play following a draw.

GROUND BALL: A ground ball denotes a change of possession from one team to another through live-ball play.

CAUSED TURNOVER: A caused turnover is the action of a player causing a turnover either by a stick check, interception/blocked pass or shot, or drawn charge.

TURNOVER: When a player loses possession of the ball and a member of the other team gains possession.

CLEAR: This team statistic is designed to demonstrate the ability of a team to take the ball from their defensive third to their offensive third.

SAVE: The save records each time a goalie stops a ball from going in her goal that if she did not stop, might result in a goal for the opponent.
